BIOGRAPHY PROFESSOR CARSTEN MAPLE

Carsten Maple is the Pro Vice Chancellor for Research & Enterprise at the University of Bedfordshire responsible for developing the University's strategy for research and enterprise activities.

Carsten has an international research reputation and extensive experience of institutional strategy development and interacting with external agencies as well as substantial experience of chairing and participating in committees and boards at all levels of an HE institution.

His research grants total over £1million. Carsten also has over 120 peer reviewed papers and is the author of the UK Security Breaches report supported by the Serious Organised Crime Agency and the Police Central e-crime Unit. He also works with advisors of the Equality and Human Rights Commission.

Carsten is a member of several professional societies including the Council of Professors and Heads of Computing (CPHC) whose remit is to promote public education in Computing and its applications and to provide a forum for those responsible for management and research in university computing departments. He is an elected member to the Committee of this body. Carsten is an Education Advisor for TIGA – the trade association representing the UK's games industry. He is also a Fellow of the British Computer Society, the Chartered Institute for IT and is a Chartered IT professional.

Carsten holds two Professorships in China, including a position at one of the top two control engineering departments in China.

His interests include Information Security and Trust and Authentication in Distributed Systems.
