



Dr Iain Phillips

Iain Phillips read for his BSc and PhD degrees at the Department of Computer Science at the University of Manchester before moving to the Loughborough University's Electronic and Electrical Engineering department in 1992. Here he worked as a Research Associate (later Fellow) on aspects of Multimedia over ATM Networks and later Multiservice Networking on projects funded by the EU, EPSRC and BT. The BT-funded work continued onto supporting BT Operational requirements of Performance Monitoring for 10 years.

In 1999 he returned to his academic home discipline of Computer Science at Loughborough as Lecturer becoming a Senior Lecturer in 2006 and appointed Head of Department from 2008-2011.

Iain was elected to the CPHC Committee in 2009 becoming Chair in 2012. His current research interests include: algorithm performance at large scales in Wireless Sensor Networks; any aspects of Internet Engineering including Routing and Performance Measurement.
