



Keith Miller

Keith Miller has a strong background in knowledge transfer having been the Principal Investigator and Academic Director of the Greater Manchester (GM) Cyber Foundry and GM AI Foundry ERDF projects at Manchester Metropolitan University (MMU). Both projects enabled researchers from four universities in the region to collaborate with SMEs to create new cyber and AI themed products and services. Each project supported over 150 SMEs and both received approx. £3m funding from the EU. More recently Keith was Co-Investigator on the Centre for Digital Innovation project in GM which received funding from the Government's Innovation Accelerator programme addressing the levelling up agenda. This project builds on the innovation model used for the Foundry projects and also addresses working with FE colleges to increase digital skills provision.

Keith was head of the Department of Computing and Mathematics at MMU for ten years and has had an international role which included setting up a joint educational institute in China. Keith has been a member of GM's Digital Steering Board, chair of the GM Cyber Advisory Group and served for six years on the committee of CPHC.
